The course participants will be able to introduce themselves and others and ask and answer questions about personal details, their areas of study, hobbies, and interests. Thus, it will make it easier for them to establish social contacts.</p> <p>Furthermore, the students will practice to communicate in typical situations of everyday life (greeting people, shopping, making appointments, being at the students' office).</p> <p>You will also be able to understand basic information in simple texts. Basic knowledge about German geography and culture will, of course, also be part of our program.</p> <p>The course contents include basic vocabulary and key phrases for communication in everyday life, the basics of German grammar, listening comprehension, speaking, reading comprehension, writing, phonetics, and German geography and culture.</p>
