You can choose from a wide variety of bachelor's and master's programs the concept that fits you the best. Whether your skills are in the scientific, technical, business or creative field, you will find your individual project with us and connect your study with moneymaking. Along with a company, you will study the study program of your choice from the areas listed in the brochure. It is possible to study all the courses here listed in cooperation.

What can you expect?

- particularly high practical relevance
- Traineeship search no longer required
- Integration in the company and in the region
- excellent chances on the job market
- Improvement of personal qualifications
- Your own income

You will basically study the same content as all the students of your degree program. However, certain mandatory elements of your studies (pre-internship, practical phase, project and bachelor thesis) will be conducted with the cooperating company. Moreover, you will work in lecture-free period or as agreed with the company. This gives you an early insight into the internal professional processes and market developments.

How does the university support you?

- We give you a personal support and help you with your application form (cover letter)
- There is a yearly job-fair at the university, a lot of workshops about the job market in the region and a database of companies on our website
- KOSMO-Mentoring-Program

Which requirements does HS Kaiserslautern ask for?

- You must fulfill the entry requirements for studying at a university in Germany. Generally, this will be pre-university qualifications (secondary education diploma) and the right language level.

How do I find a company?

- Apply to a partner company (see www.kosmo.hs-kl.de). Following this, a contract of employment will be concluded with the company. Prospective students can also apply themselves to new companies or contact us – the Department of Business and Transfer www.hs-kl.de/transfer. The university concludes a framework cooperation agreement with each company.
- Apply for the desired degree program at the University of Kaiserslautern by submitting the employment contract.

Beginning:

- The dual-study KOSMO starts in 1.st Semester
- "Lateral entry" (free-admission programs) possible until 4th Semester
