The entry requirements for universities sometimes include (depending on your final school grades) successful completion of an assessment test.

TARGET GROUP

Potential foreign students with an indirect entitlement to higher education who must complete an assessment test.

REQUIREMENTS

Residency permit, B2 language exam, education certificates for access to higher education by means of an assessment test in accordance with the evaluation criteria (German: Bewertung-svorschläge - BV) published in the database at http://anabin.kmk.org under "Hochschulzugang".

APPLICATION

You can apply to the Hochschule Kaiserslautern's International Preparatory College online via our homepage. For the summer semester, the application deadline is October 15th of the preceding year, and for the winter semester, the deadline is April 15th of the same year.

Our courses

The International Preparatory College at the Hochschule Kaiserslautern offers courses focusing on T/TI, which can then be used for admission to technical life sciences and engineering sciences-related courses of study. It also offers courses that focus on W/WW that will allow you to pursue a degree in a field related to business studies. Our preparatory courses only last 1 semester.

SUBJECTS

T/TI: German, Mathematics and IT, Physics
W/WW: German, Mathematics and IT, Economics
and Business Administration

AIM

At the end of each semester, i.e. twice a year, there are assessment tests held for each subject in the chosen course. Passing this exam will allow you to pursue a course of study at a (Fach-)Hochschule or university.



Kaiserslautern, with around 100,000 inhabitants, is the center of the German Palatinate region. The city has a long history and offers a rich array of culture: theaters, museums, concerts, and several movie theaters. In the city center, you can

also find the Japanese Garden and the Gartenschau, which is home to the largest dinosaur exhibit in Europe. The Palatinate Forest starts just to the south of the city and is perfect for hiking, cycle trips, and even has a castle you can visit. Kaiserslau-tern is also home to 1. FCK, a well-known football club. For sports fans, there are also several swimming pools, both indoor and open-air, a climbing facility, and much more.

Kaiserslautern has a Technische Universität and a (Fach-)Hochschule. Furthermore, many reputable research institutions have settled in the area, such as the German Research Center for Artificial Intelligence, two Fraunhofer institutes, and a Max-Planck institute, so that Kaiserslautern is becom-ing more and more of a research location with a focus on IT.

The city has excellent transport connections to major European cities thanks to the IC and ICE rail network (1.5 hours to Frankfurt am Main, 2.5 hours to Paris, France).
